

MR. LADELL FORTUNE has been the Choral Director at Butler High School for the past 7 years. All BHS Choirs under his direction have consistently received Superior and Excellent Ratings in Performance and Sight-Reading at yearly Performance Evaluations. In 2008, Mr. Fortune successfully led the Advanced Ensemble and Concert Choir to first place victories at the Music in The Parks Choral Competition in Atlanta, GA. Ladell Fortune is a proud 1998 graduate of Butler High School. He attended



Georgia Southern University where he majored in Music Education receiving a Bachelors of Arts degree in Vocal Music Education in December of 2002. In August 2008, Mr. Fortune received his Master of Music Education degree from Boston University. In the future, he plans to pursue a Doctoral Degree in Choral Conducting. For six years, Mr. Fortune served as the Choral Music Teacher at The Jessye Norman School of The Arts here in Augusta, GA. Currently, he is a member of the Augusta Chorale and the Augusta Chorale Singers. He has directed several choirs for many churches and religious aggregations locally, regionally and even nationally. He also serves on the Quorum of Choir Directors for the International Churches of God in Christ. Mr. Fortune is involved in many organizations which include Georgia Music Educators Association, Lead Choral Team for Richmond County, Georgia Association of Educators, National Association of Educators, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia the professional men's music fraternity, and he is the Fine Arts Department Chair at Butler High School.

MS. SHERRY PURYEAR, a native of Bronx, NY, is a graduate of Kentucky State University with a degree in music education. Ms. Puryear, a saxophonist and vocalist, currently teaches band at Glenn Hills High School. Several of Ms. Puryear's students are assisting us with our rhythm section in today's concert: James Hopkins, Bass; Anthony Crawford, Trumpet; Bryan Curry, Drums; David Roberts, Trombone.



MISS ANGELA ARRINGTON has been the long-time and dedicated accompanist for the Augusta Chorale since 1983. She is a native Augustan who played various tunes at age two and played with both hands by age five. Ms. Arrington recognized her extraordinary talent and studied piano at Turner Baldwin School of Music and with the Connors. She earned a Bachelor's degree in Mathematics/Computer Science with a music minor at Oakwood College. She is organist and pianist at Ebenezer Seventh Day Adventist Church.



DR. PHYLLIS W. ANDERSON returned to the podium in 2007 when the Augusta Chorale invited her to be its artistic director. Since then, the Chorale has produced Handel's Messiah accompanied by the Suzuki Strings of Augusta, and has appeared with Mr. Isaac Holmes, Mr. Timothy Boyd and Ms. LaOuita Mitchell. The Chorale performs regularly for the community at the GA War Veterans Nursing Home, the Lucy Craft Laney Museum, the Richmond County Public Schools, the Arts in the Heart of Augusta Festival, and at various Paine College



events. Dr. Phyllis Anderson earned her music degrees at Norfolk State University, Ohio State University, and the University of GA. Presently, she is an elementary music specialist with the Columbia County Schools. Prior to teaching elementary music, Dr. Anderson was a tenured Associate Professor of Music and Choir Director at Paine College for 13 years; moreover her Concert Choir was well-known for fine choral music around Augusta and throughout the state. Dr. Anderson is married to Walter W. Anderson; their son Joseph is a freshman at Augusta State University
