Soprano Kathye Gary

Soprano Kathye Gary of Atlanta, Georgia made her debut with the Augusta Chorale in December 2008 when she sang the soprano solos in Handel's Messiah. Mrs. Kathye Gary' artistry left the audience spellbound even though she accepted the invitation to sing with the Chorale 4 hours before the concert, never practiced with the organist, and had never met the director. She has sung in some of the most famous opera houses in the world. Her intensive voice instruction was all by private lessons, often three days a week for three years. "It was like going back to school all over," she said.

She earned her degree in marketing from Morris Brown College, with a minor in electrical engineering. Her love for singing didn't end, and it wasn't long before she began private voice lessons and auditions. Mrs. Gary starred in the Americolor Opera production of "Madame C.J.," the story of the first female African-American millionaire, Madame C.J. Walker of Atlanta.

Bass-Baritone Washington Isaac Holmes

The Augusta Chorale is happy to welcome back Bass-Baritone Washington Isaac Holmes, a native of Graniteville, SC. Mr. Holmes received a B.M.A. from The University of South Carolina, where he studied with Laurie Christie, Harry Cardwell, and Donald Gray. He has an M.M. from The University of Michigan, where he majored in vocal performance studying with George Shirley and Leslie Guinn. While at U of M, he studied vocal literature with Martin Katz, Mitchell Krieger, the late Geoffrey Parsons, and Margo Garrett, among others.

Holmes has performed as soloist, dancer, instrumentalist, and chorister in the United States, South Korea, Germany, France, Great Britain, Holland, Hungary, the Czech Republic, and Belgium. Further, he has traveled abroad for vocal and language study. Mr. Holmes has served as guest soloist throughout the CSRA. He is Assistant Professor of Music at Paine College and Artistic director of the Columbia County Choral Society. He brings an extensive array of experience including international tours, Dubois' "Seven Last Words" and "Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde."

Pianist Dr. Rosalyn W. Floyd

Dr. Rosalyn W. Floyd, accompanist for the Augusta Choral Society, is a Professor in the Department of Fine Arts at Augusta State University, where she teaches piano, music theory, and humanities. A native of Charleston, SC, Dr. Floyd holds the Bachelor of Arts in music from Talladega College in Alabama, the Master of Music and Doctor of Music Arts degrees in Piano Performance and Pedagogy from the University of South Carolina.

Dr. Floyd's musical experiences include former membership in the Charleston Symphony Orchestra, rehearsal pianist for the Columbia Lyric Opera and accompanist to the USC Opera Workshop. Dr. Floyd was selected to accompany Martina Arroyo and Myrtle Hall in their performances for Pope John Paul II.
